Our Mission

Backboard and support quote has not arrived yet. This may be a G.F purchase or ESSR (unless we use the ESSR to purchase uniforms. Floor tile in the commons/gym needs to be replaced, after conducting an inspection of the carpet throughout the building, the funds normally spent on carpet will be spent on the tile. Media in the water filtration system needs to be replaced after samples of water have shown increasing (but still safe levels) of arsenic. Roof over the Commons, and a portion of the kitchen area, essentially all of the middle section minus the MPR. Parking Lot repair, seal and restripe had two quotes for the BOE to choose between. Hoping to have a quote for the Asbestos abatement this week or next prior to the BOE Meeting. The cost of a new floor installed would run just shy of \$110,000.

This is not a public meeting; rather it is a meeting of the Camden-Frontier Board of Education held in public. Provision for public comment is available at the beginning and the end of the meeting. Public comment is limited to three minutes. Speakers must be recognized by the Board President and state their name and address for the official record.
