l. Discussion Items

- a. **EBLI-Petersen Handwriting Kits-** makes sense to have the handwriting kits match the curriculum
- b. **Future Proud Michigan Educator Explore** is a course designed to raise student awareness of educational strategies, systems and professions. This course engages learners in a study of student identity and the ways in which those identities are developed in learning communities. Students will examine issues that affect their education, including personal and systemic influences. Through classroom assignments and clinical experiences, students will analyze teaching and learning practices as they receive mentorship and experiential learning. Students will use the course content and experiences to plan and prepare for their own educational pathways.
 - i. We have student participating in this program and it would allow our staff to work with them for a stipend paid by the program.
- c. **Feedback from Staff member on Curriculum-** Science curriculum uses a lot of inquiry which is a higher order thinking skill from Blooms Taxonomy, our students are not quite ready to master this but need to be exposed.
