Discussed the future of the gym floor whether that be rebranding if the mascot is retired or replacement. We have received quotes for both projects. One proposal will require more information to be sought due to likely asbestos abatement which could double the cost of the project. Discussed the use of ESSR or Security Grant funds to cover cost of communications upgrade for buses and security cameras (waiting on Habitec). Walked area where new concrete and netting will be constructed to protect the new siding on back building. Still need to consider new East end addition for future growth of early childhood education and daycare.
