Scholarship Application

The Montgomery United Methodist Church Scholarship Committee will present four (4) **\$2,000.00** non-renewable scholarships to graduates meeting the following criteria:

- Two **\$2,000** non-renewable scholarships to two graduates pursuing a 2-year/trade school degree
- Two **\$2,000** non-renewable scholarships to two graduates pursuing a 4-year degree

Eligibility:

1. Applicants may attend any accredited 2- or 4-year college, university, business, vocational, or trade school. Students may attend on either a full- or part-time schedule.
2. Applicants must submit a completed Montgomery United Methodist Church Scholarship packet by April 1st of each school year.
3. Student's grade point average (GPA) must be a 2.5 or higher at the time of application.
4. Applicants will include a one-page, double-spaced essay which addresses his/her future plans.
5. Applicants will include the name, address and phone number of the college/trade school/university where he/she plans to attend.

Selection Criteria:

1. High school transcript including SAT or ACT scores.
2. Attendance patterns through high school will be considered.
3. Financial need shall be a factor.
4. Applicants must include a letter of recommendation from a teacher, administrator or staff member at Camden-Frontier.
5. School activities and community service activities will be considered. Academic honors and awards are encouraged.
6. Residence may be a factor.
7. Applicants may be offered an interview prior to final selections.
